Every 6 years the Electoral Rolls across the whole of the Church of England are renewed. Joining an electoral roll says in effect 'I belong' to the parish church. Everyone who wants to be on an electoral roll will need to complete and return a form. Please check the closing dates for your particular parish particularly if you are a member of the PCC or a sidesperson as you must be on the Electoral Roll!
